

Harvard Ph.D.'s during the Pigeon Lab era

The following listing of Ph.D.s is based upon a plaque, "Doctorates in Psychology," mounted outside the office of the Department of Psychology in William James Hall, Harvard University. The earliest degree was awarded to G. Stanley Hall in 1878; Fred S. Keller and B. Fred Skinner are listed as degree recipients in 1931. Through 1947, all doctorates were awarded in Psychology. From 1948 through 1972, the plaque lists doctorates both in Psychology and in Social Relations, then a separate department. That is an appropriate year to begin the list here, because it is also the year in which Skinner began his academic appointment at Harvard, following his William James lectures in 1947. The Department of Psychology at the time was, in effect, a department of experimental psychology; the Department of Social Relations included other areas, such as clinical and social psychology. The list below ends with Psychology degrees in 1972. In that year, two degrees were awarded in Psychology and eighteen in Social Relations. Following the merger of the two departments in 1972, the departmental plaque provides no information about the specializations of subsequent degree recipients. Within the 1948-1972 period covered, no attempt has been made to distinguish between those who were actively involved in the pigeon lab and those who were peripherally or even minimally involved with it. --A.C.
